CHECKLIST OF 'THE WASP AND THE EAGLE', THE JOURNAL OF THE 3rd EAST ANGLIAN REGIMENT

(Updated 9 Jun 15)

- 1. 'The Wasp and The Eagle' came into existence after the formation of the 3rd East Anglian Regiment on 2 June 1958 by the amalgamation of the Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire Regiment and the Essex Regiment.
- 2. Serial 1 below was issued a month after the formation of the 3rd East Anglian Regiment. It is the penultimate issue of 'The Wasp, Journal of The 16th Foot, The Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire Regiment', but it contains some items relevant to the amalgamated regiment and as such deserves a place in this checklist.
- 3. Serials 2 and 3 below were issued simultaneously. The coloured covers are identical: 'The Wasp and The Eagle The Amalgamation of The 16th, 44th and 56th Regiments', the Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire Regiment badge and an eagle. About one third of the content is common. However:
 - a. The title page of Serial 2 reads 'The Wasp, The Journal of The 16th Foot, The Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire Regiment'; numbering is sequential from previous issues of 'The Wasp'; page headers all read 'The Wasp'.
 - b. The title page of Serial 3 reads 'The Eagle, The Journal of The Essex Regiment, Amalgamation Number'; numbering is sequential from previous issues of 'The Eagle'; page headers all read, alternately, 'The Eagle', and 'The Journal of The Essex Regiment'.
- 4. Serial 4, although published 6 months after the formation of the 3rd East Anglian Regiment, was the final issue of 'The Wasp', but the content is of course relevant to the amalgamated regiment hence its inclusion in this checklist.
- 5. Serials 5-9 were described on the cover and inside as the 'Regimental Journal of The 3rd East Anglian Regiment (16th/44th Foot)'. Serials 10-16 used the wording 'Regimental Journal of The Pompadours, The 3rd East Anglian Regiment (16th/44th Foot)'.
- 6. All of the issues listed below include the markings 'Supplement No 1' and 'Supplement No 2' on some, but by no means all, of the bound-in advertisement pages, apparently provided by a central agency covering many Service journals.
